#### **FILING REQUIREMENTS**

The Summary of Articles of Amalgamation must be filed with the applicable fees and an original of the following:

- Notice of Address/Change of Address (Form SA0091),
- Amalgamation Agreement, if any,
- Notice of Initial Execution/Termination of a Unanimous Agreement (Form SA0090), if applicable,
- declaration required under Section 274(2) of the Cooperatives Act (Form SA0098), and
- if a new name is adopted, an Alberta Name Search Report (from the NUANS database) is required dated not more than 90 days prior to the date the Articles of Amalgamation are received by the Alberta Government.

TO WIT:

This declaration must be made by the directors of each amalgamating cooperative and is to be filed along with the Articles of Amalgamation form.

#### solemnly declare:

- 1. that the amalgamated cooperative will be organized and operated, and will carry on business, on a cooperative basis,
- if the amalgamated cooperative is one to which Part 18 of the Cooperatives Act applies (housing, employment, multi-stakeholder, new generation cooperative), that the amalgamated cooperative will comply with the applicable division of Part 18 of the Cooperatives Act,
- 3. that there are reasonable grounds to believe that
  - each amalgamating cooperative is, and the amalgamated cooperative will be, able to pay its liabilities as they become due, and
  - (ii) the realizable value of the amalgamated cooperative's assets will not be less than the total of its liabilities and stated capital of all classes,
- 4. that there are reasonable grounds to believe that
  - (i) no creditor will be prejudiced by the amalgamation, or
  - (ii) adequate notice has been given to all known creditors of the amalgamating cooperatives and no creditor has objected to the amalgamation otherwise than on grounds that are frivolous or vexatious.
